## Indiana Youth Survey Recruitment Tips

## Be prepared!

- Know if the school corporation has registered for the upcoming survey.
- Determine who would be the best person at the school to discuss the INYS.
- Seek other community and school supports to encourage school personnel's interest.
- Understand and be comfortable discussing the benefits of INYS participation with the school.
- Be ready to share specific tasks you will do to support the school's participation (e.g., assisting with survey administration, interpreting results).
- Contact the INYS coordinator (or your project officer) with any remaining questions or concerns.

Convenient	<ul> <li>Takes only 30 minutes to complete</li> <li>Can administer the survey on any date between late January and</li> </ul>
Customizable	Can add up to 15 additional questions of your choosing
Confidential	<ul> <li>Student responses are confidential</li> <li>Only your school corporation will have access to your results</li> </ul>
Valuable	<ul> <li>Gathers local data necessary for grant writing, program improvement, and strategic planning</li> </ul>
Believable	<ul> <li>Self-report data is screened for inconsistencies and dishonest responses are excluded from analysis</li> </ul>
