ALL SCHOOLS ARE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE

The Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction provides funding that allows all schools in Indiana to participate in the INYS in **even-numbered years** for free (Previously, the survey had been funded annually).

The INYS uses random sampling techniques to generate representative data on the statewide level. Schools not chosen in the random sample **ARE STILL WELCOME** to participate.

ABOUT THE SURVEY

- The INYS is a self-reported adolescent survey that assesses factors related to student success.
- Indiana schools can conduct the INYS for free during the spring semester of the 2023-2024 school year with 6th-12th grade students.
- All results are confidential, and student participation is voluntary.
- Available in online format.
- Takes approximately 30 minutes to administer.
- In 2022, more than 90,000 students from over 300 schools participated in the INYS.

BENEFITS

- Receive a school corporation report combining student responses by grade level.
- Add up to 15 additional questions to get data on local issues (optional).
- Compare local corporation data with statewide and national results.
- Use data to inform school policies, gather data necessary for grant writing, and determine prevention efforts.
